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- 1. BIDS** - TAMPA BAY WATER, A Regional Water Supply Authority will receive sealed BIDS addressed to the RECORDS DEPARTMENT at the offices of TAMPA BAY WATER, 2575 Enterprise Road, Clearwater, Florida 33763-1102, **2:00 p.m., local time, on Thursday, September 10, 2009.** All BIDS that have been timely received will be opened publicly.
- 2. PROJECT Description** - The Name of the PROJECT is **OFF-STREAM RESERVOIR PUMP STATION.**

- 3. Location** - The PROJECT is located in Hillsborough County, Florida.
- 4. General - Description of WORK** - The WORK contemplated consists of, but is not limited to:  
Construction of pump station consisting of four 400-hp variable-speed vertical turbine pumps; valve vault; electrical building; electrical systems and lighting; piping and valves; instrumentation and controls; HVAC system; and miscellaneous site improvements. Install valves, fittings and appurtenances to connect to the existing 84-Inch Reservoir transmission main.
- 5. Defined Terms** - All defined terms are found in the Definitions Section of the General Conditions.
- 6. Bid Documents** - Complete sets of BID DOCUMENTS are available for review or purchase beginning Friday, August 7, 2009 at the office of TAMPA BAY WATER's ENGINEER, Camp Dresser & McKee, Inc., 1715 N. Westshore Blvd., #875, Tampa, Florida 33607. A payment of **One-hundred Fifty dollars and No/cents (\$150.00)** in check payable to Camp Dresser & McKee, Inc. will be required to purchase each complete set of the BID DOCUMENTS. These payments represent reproduction, handling, and postage costs and are non-refundable.
- 7. BID SECURITY** - BID SECURITY in the amount of five percent (5%) of the PROPOSED TOTAL CONTRACT PRICE must accompany each BID in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
- 8. Pre-Bid Conference** - A pre-bid conference will be held at Tampa Bay Water's Baymont Inn & Suites Sabal Park (Manatee Room) 10007 Princess Palm Avenue, Tampa, Florida, 33619, **on Tuesday, August 18, 2009 at 2:30 p.m.** **Attendance at the pre-bid conference is mandatory** and all prospective BIDDERS are required to attend the conference. TAMPA BAY WATER may issue ADDENDA as necessary in response to questions arising at the conference.

- 9. ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDY - Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, any objection to or protest of the form and content of the BID DOCUMENTS and/or the actions of TAMPA BAY WATER.**
- 10. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES STATEMENT –** Pursuant to Subsections 287.133(2) and (3), Florida Statutes, a person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid, proposal or reply on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity; may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work; may not submit bids, proposals, or replies on leases or real property to a public entity; may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity; and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, for CATEGORY TWO, for a period of 36 months following the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.
- 11. DISCRIMINATION -** Pursuant to Subsection 287.134(2)(a), Florida Statutes, an entity or affiliate who has been placed on the discriminatory vendor list may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity; may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work; may not submit bids, proposals, or replies on leases of real property to a public entity; may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity; and may not transact business with any public entity.
