Grants between \$2,000 and \$10,000 are awarded per organization through Tampa Bay Water's source water protection mini-grant program.

The program is available to nonprofit organizations, universities, colleges, community groups or school groups located within Hillsborough County, Pasco County or Pinellas County. Grant recipients are announced each December and funding is awarded upon project completion.

- River and stream clean-ups
- Efforts to protect and conserve the region's watersheds and aquifer recharge zones
- Innovative projects to reduce pollution in wetlands, rivers and coastal areas
