Get your share of the funding! Grants ranging from \$2,000 to \$10,000 are available to community groups, nonprofits, school groups and educational institutions located in Hillsborough, Pasco and Pinellas Counties.

Examples of Qualifying Projects Include

- River and stream cleanups
- Riverbank restoration and stabilization
- Protection and preservation of the region's watersheds
- Innovative solutions to reduce pollution in wetlands, rivers and coastal areas
- Educational resources for teaching the water cycle and water stewardship
- Public outreach campaigns such as workshops, signage, art projects or exhibits

Source water protection includes a wide variety of actions and activities aimed at safeguarding, maintaining or improving sources of drinking water and their surrounding watersheds. Everything that happens on the ground will eventually make its way to the water.
